WATER NOTICE!

To all water customers:

During the evening of Thursday, December 6, 2018 the Township Water Department will be opening certain valves within the water supply system. This may cause temporary discolored water or entrain air into the system. Air entrainment in the water is not contamination. Air entrainment is a condition that exists within pipes for a temporary time. You may experience some cloudy water. In this instance simply run your cold water tap for 10 minutes and this condition should clear up. Additionally, you may experience water pressure fluctuations. It may take several hours for water pressures to equalize. You should not ever be without water being supplied to your home or business.

The reason that water system valves are being opened in certain locations throughout the municipal water system is because the Great Lakes Water Authority (GLWA) needs to perform a test analysis of the large transmission water main that traverses from east to west along 14 Mile Road. This is a diligent follow up from the main break that occurred in late October, 2017. All master meter vault feeds from the GLWA will be closed. Therefore, the Water Department must work to redistrict its internal water systems in order to accommodate for this upcoming testing.
